

Apple Cider Vanilla Ice Cream Cinnamon A jar or glass








Window Tree



- Walk to gather some supplies from nature (make sure they are dried well before using)
- Supplies needed: brown construction paper, transparent tape and transparent contact paper, Fall looking items (yarn, pieces of paper, small flatitems from nature)



- Unroll large square of contact paper on table sticky side down and tape it down
- Add all the fun things you want including glitter if you dare
- Put same size piece of contact paper on top, pressing or rolling to flatten.
- Cut it into leaf shapes Cut out construction paper trunk and tape to window



- Tape on leaves
- During activity you can talk about the seasons; talk about the weather; songs about the seasons, books about the seasons
